NMMRO Statement on crosswalk vandalism

On June 5th, 2019 videos surfaced of motorcyclists vandalizing the cross walk at Morningside and Central avenue in Albuquerque. We as an organization and as a community, are appalled at the senseless acts of vandalism. The New Mexico Motorcyclist Rights Organization does not condone street racing or reckless endangerment of riders, the public or innocent bystanders, acts of vandalism or any form of discrimination.

Our organization works diligently to protect the rights of all motorcyclists in our state, regardless of their race, religion, or sexual orientation. Our community is acutely aware of the impacts of profiling and discrimination, and fight to defend against it. We also understand that the actions of a group or an individual, can have a grossly negative impact on the perception of motorcyclists in our state.
